

KANSAS GAS SERVICE TO UPGRADE NATURAL GAS PIPELINES IN ST. JOHN

OVERLAND PARK, Kan. – June 21, 2010 – Kansas Gas Service will begin upgrading distribution service lines and relocating natural gas meters throughout the city of St. John, Kan., beginning Monday, June 28.

"This project is a part of our regularly scheduled maintenance plan and is a system-improvement program," said Conrad Koehler, manager of community relations for Kansas Gas Service.

Customers affected by this project will be notified by Miller Paving and Construction, the contractor assisting Kansas Gas Service, or by a service notification card that will be posted at their home or business. The project is expected to be completed in October and company officials do not anticipate any major interruption to traffic flow.

Kansas Gas Service provides clean, reliable natural gas to more than 643,000 customers in 337 communities in Kansas. It is a division of ONEOK, Inc. (NYSE: OKE), a diversified energy company.
